



### PREVENTION PROGRAMS

**REPORT** child abuse and neglect to the authorities if you suspect it. Contact the local Department of Family and Children Services or the police. Let them decide what to do about it.

**ATTEND** or support a local training on parent education, positive discipline or bullying.

**SUPPORT** home visiting programs. We know they reduce child abuse and neglect.

**ADVOCATE** for programs and policies that support families and keep children safe.
